Member Presentation: A member will show a 10-minute DVD on nuclear waste disposal and that will be followed by a discussion of relevant facts about nuclear power that may be informative for utility stock investors.

Mutual Funds: The downside of ETFs: Many are mainly trading vehicles for professional investors and recent market volatility has revealed some of their limitations. Also, the current issue of *Barron's* features a lengthy interview with John Segner, manager of the AIM Energy Fund (FSTEX). Segner is bullish on energy over the long term based on steadily rising demand in the face of difficulties in replacing reserves. He's especially bullish on oil service stocks, which are probably best bought by most individual investors through mutual funds.

Stock Talk: Raytheon (RTN) and Textron (TXT)

On the Website: Each week on Friday, the PBS Nightly Business Report features a "Market Monitor" interview which usually includes specific investment recommendations. Last Friday's interview featured buy recommendations on several Canadian energy trusts that pay rich dividends.
