*ETFs 201 and 301.* Remember your college course numbers? Level 101 was for Freshman, 201 was for sophomores, and 301 was for juniors. This week's <u>Barrons</u> has a Special Report on ETFs, including emerging uses of ETFs in portfolios; alternatives ETFs (ETNs, managed ETFs, leveraged ETFs;) and the three ETF structures and how ETFs actually work. This last one may be Level 401 or graduate level, and only for those want to dig deep.
