Market Perspective. The markets were mostly down last wee, with the DOW down 1.25%; the S&P down 1.06%, and the NASDAQ up 0.18%. All eyes are, of course, on the pointless shenanigans in Congress over the budget. If we get through this, then we get to do it again in a few weeks with even more at stake - the debt ceiling. Is everybody as disgusted with this circus as I am? It is costing investors real money with our portfolios, and could get much worse. But then, I suppose there is opportunity for the risk-takers, positioning a portfolio to buy should the markets tank.

Interest rates, on the other hand, have dropped in the past three weeks, with the 10-year Treasury bond declining about 3/10th of 1%. Both bond and equity prices seem to be reacting to the budget and debt ceiling talks, which are overshadowing economic news.

Panel on Stock Buying. Sy Sherman, Bob Bohall, Alan Glenn, and Burgess Levin will talk about picking stocks: what stocks get on their "radar screen," how the follow and analyze them, how they decide to buy, how much they buy, and whatever else comes to mind on the decision to buy stocks. Sy Sherman is a regular speaker, but Bob and Alan are newcomers to the front of the class. And Burgess is new to OLLI, with a red dot on his name tag! Welcome to the deep end of the pool, Burgess.

This panel discussion should be of particular interest to those of you who invest mainly in funds, but are thinking about investing directly in stocks. Interaction with the panelists (asking questions) is invited.
