Everybody is paying attention to Greece, which economy is a slow-motion train wreck, and wondering when (not if) Greece will finally default on its debt, and get booted from the EU. Or whether Germany (not known for playing nice with other countries) will fashion some sort of bailout of Greece. That a nation with an economy smaller than Oregon's economy could have such an impact on global markets is a mystery to me.

Dividend Investing. Next week, on June 24, we will have a panel discussion of Josh Peters' investing strategy from his newsletter, "Morningstar Dividend Investor." We have room for more panelists; let me know if you would like to be a panelist, to field questions from me.

As a lead-in to the panel, I would like to discuss, this week, dividend investing in general, compared to being a growth or value investor in stocks. Lou Coglianese has suggested some topics:
