Market Perspective. Another quiet week, continuing a pattern since the Brexit vote in June. For the week, the DOW was down 0.9%; the S&P down 0.7%; and the NASDAQ down 0.4%. All eyes were on Jackson Hole and the Fed's policy meeting there, and the announcements on Friday that indicated the likelihood of a rate increase in September or December (or both?) It is hard to remember the time when the Fed raising rates was in response to a strengthening economy, which benefits stocks.

On September 1 (this Thursday,) the 11th S&P sector will be born, as the real estate sector will be split off from the financial sector, where it currently resides. This sector will consist mostly of REITS, and be a relatively small sector, with about 3% of the market cap of the S&P 500. The financial sector will shrink, as a percentage of the S&P 500, from 15.7% to 12.7%.

Keynesian Economics. For those of us who last studied Keynesian Economics in Econ 201, Garrett Cochran will give a tutorial on Mr. Keynes and his still relevant book from 1936. Should we address you as "Professor," Garrett?

Barron's 10 Best Dividend Stocks. This week's Barron's list ten large cap stocks, that have good dividends but are not overpriced and have good prospects. Those are: Verizon (VZ); MetLife (MET); Dow Chemical (DOW); Qualcomm (QCOM), Cisco (CSCO); Target (TGT): Carnival Cruise Lines (CCL); JP Morgan (JPM); and US Bancorp (USB). All familiar names, for sure, and I suspect that most of us own several. What do you think of the list, and do you think some of those names should not be there?
