Welcome to the Tom Crooker Investment Forum. The Spring Term will meet 11:50AM to 1:15PM, on Wednesdays from March 22 to May 17, 2017, <u>at Lord of Life Lutheran Church, 5114 Twinbrook Road, Fairfax.</u> Park in back of the church and enter through the back entrance. We normally meet in the Fellowship Hall, or in the Sanctuary if the Fellowship Hall is unavailable.

Market Perspective. Markets moved little for the week. The DOW and NASDAQ were each up less than 0.1%, and the S&P was up 0.2%. The big news was that the Fed, as widely expected, raised its Federal Funds rate by 0.25%, but but was somewhat "dovish" on further rate increases in 2017.

Corporate Tax Reform and the BAT (Border Adjustment Tax.) Thank you, Brenda Bloch-Young, for "splainin" the BAT to us last week. This incomprehensible subject and its impact on investors will be much discussed in coming months. <u>Barron's</u> echoed many of the same concerns about the BAT's unknown impacts in its lead story on Saturday.

Value Investing. Tom Crooker will offer observations on value investing, and some funds that do it well.

Future Topics

On March 29 (tentatively), Ludwig Benner and Ed Swoboda will discuss "When to Sell." If you have metrics or thresholds that trigger sell decisions, please share those.

We will have our "DOW 21,000" sheet cake on March 29, at the end of the session.
