Turkey's currency plunged on Friday, August 10, raising concerns of "contagion," and prompting a threat of new US tariffs on Turkish aluminum and steel.

Daily threats and posturing over tariffs and trade sanctions.

Bump-up in US inflation numbers and a strengthening US dollar.

Generally good corporate earnings for the second quarter and good US economic numbers.

Apple \$1 trillion (see below) and Elon Musk taking Tesla private???

**Robo Investing.** Brenda Bloch-Young will go over "The Robo Report, Second Quarter 2018," posted on the Forum website. The report compares various portfolios offered and rates providers. Robo investing is a fast growing and evolving segment of the industry, which may be eventually be of interest to many of us.

**Agriculture.** John Woods, the Forum's (only?) expert on farming, will update us on the current state of Ag. Farm product prices have been hurt by tariffs imposed by nations in retaliation to US trade policies, raising the possibility of government subsidies to help out farmers.
