*Market Perspective.* Markets were down for the week, with the drop caused by tech and "momentum" stocks - which have been the big winners lately. For the week, the DOW was down 0.2%; the S&P down 1.0%; and the NASDAQ down 2.6%. Is this a short-lived blip for tech stocks, or reversion to the mean?

The flattening yield curve got a bit less flat, with the 2-10 spread rising to .24%. Still very flat, but less flat than the .19% two weeks ago.

10th Anniversary of Lehman. This week's Barron's, Saturday's Wall Street Journal, and Sunday's Washington Post, all had special reports on the 10th anniversary of the collapse of Lehman Bros, which kicked the Great Recession into high gear. All have insightful articles and are good reads, with interesting comments on the causes of the recession from a ten-year look back, how it impacted investors and a "lost generation" of investors, and what is now lurking that might bring on the next downturn.

**Searching for Yield.** The 8/22/2018 Buy and Sell list had a buy, AGNC Investment Corp (AGNC), a mortgage REIT, with a yield of 11.4%. We will talk about mortgage REITS, and the risks investors take to get such lofty yields.

**DOW 25,000 sheet cake.** We will celebrate DOW 25,000, which happened some time ago, this Wednesday at the end of class.

*Garrett Ruhl comments.* Starting this week and continuing in the Fall term, Garrett Ruhl will discuss the use of <u>ValueLine</u> to select and analyze stocks, and portfolio construction and financial planning for investors without pensions, or who are funding significant living expenses from their portfolios.
