Another up week. The markets have recovered over half of the losses from the all-time high on February 19, and are now 15% below that high. Despite awful unemployment numbers, GDP contraction, and uncertainty when the virus turns around and when the economy will reopen and we assess the damage. What's going on? Have we seen the market's bottom? Or is another leg down out there, waiting to bite us?

For the week, the DOW was up 2.2%; the S&P was up 3.0%; and the NASDAQ was up 6.1%. The Fed is continuing to buy everything in site, and optimism that a new drug, Remdesivir (who makes up these names) may treat (not cure) covid 19.

Nothing speaks louder than the buy and sell list, which reflects opportunities and risks that we see. Also important is what is not on the list.
