Markets. In the two weeks since we last met, markets had strong up moves. The DOW was up 6.9% and 4.1%; the S&P was up 7.3% and 2.2%; the NASDAQ was up 9.0% and then down 0.6%; and the Russell 2000 was up 6.9% and up 6.1%. Election week, markets seemed positive on the likelihood of divided government, and last week news of Pfizer's vaccine rallied the market and offset rising pandemic infection numbers.
