Markets. Another up week, despite news events that could have been market downers: disturbances in DC, Senate flip, awful pandemic numbers, slow vaccine roll out, and jobs losses. Takeaways (my opinion only.) Markets are forward looking and expecting a rebound (V shaped recovery) with vaccinations and pent up consumer spending and hiring; additional stimulus; the market is not particularly concerned about the new administration and unified control of the government; and finally, the market welcomes less drama and more stability.

For the first week of 2021, the DOW was up 1.6%; the S&P was up 1.8%; the NASDAQ was up 2.4%; and the Russell 2000 was up 5.9% (!). The usual attention getters - Tesla, tech, ARK funds, and Bitcoin, continued their runs. Anybody see bubbles or irrational exuberance? Inflation, with rising long term interest rates are getting noticed.

Fourth quarter 2020 earnings kick off this week.
